If through our monitoring we find that certain groups of people aren't using particular services we can address this to ensure that everyone gets equal access - regardless of their age, disability, sex, race, religion/belief or sexual orientation.

We need to be confident in asking these questions of residents and service users in our day-to-day roles, whether in surveys, over the phone or in person.

It's useful to remember that:

- information provided is confidential under data protection legislation
- information is not passed onto anyone else
- people are not obliged to provide this information, but we should ask
